

Kensington Unitarians: Raising Funds for the Work of Our Community

Reasons we want to raise money in 2019:

- Increased staff hours, fair wages and pensions, supporting our great staff team in getting more done.
- Most of our income comes through letting our building – but we want to ensure that community minded groups that can't afford our charges can continue to use our meeting space for free or for reduced fees.
- Keep our busy building in tip top condition – we've renovated the parquet floors in 2018. Next we hope to tackle wiring and plumbing problems and sort out problems with the garden back wall.

How much does it cost to run our building and church community?

- Our annual budget is at least £150,000. That's £3,000 running costs each week.

How can I donate?

- A monthly, or annual, standing order is the simplest way to support the church.
- A one off donation by cheque or bank transfer is always most welcome. Let us know if you want that contribution to go towards a particular project or purchase.
- We are grateful to all who give to collections made in our Sunday service.
- We appreciate everyone who has made provision for Essex Church in their will.

How much shall I give?

- We encourage people only to give as much as they feel they can afford. For example, current standing orders vary from £10 to £50 a month.
- And we don't expect a contribution every Sunday you're at church. Just give what you can when you can. We cannot put a price on the value of volunteering – there are many ways to support our community.

In 2018 we are separating this request for financial support from our annual membership drive. You do not have to pay to be a member of our community, but every penny you give us will help to continue our work in the world. Please let us know when you take out a standing order or make a one-off donation, so we can thank you properly, and keep up-to-date records.
